

# Maintenance - laminate

## 1. TAKE SOME PRECAUTIONS

- Clean the floor regularly with a vacuum cleaner or soft broom; particles of dirt and grit that are left behind can damage the surface of the floor.
- Remove stains immediately with a well-wrung cloth. Worn-in stains are difficult to remove.
- Avoid excessive wet mopping or cleaning with pure water. Also, do not use a traditional cleaning product.
- Place small carpets or rugs on high-traffic areas.
- Place doormats at exterior doors.
- Place beige, felt floor protectors under chair and table legs; do not use coloured floor protectors!
- Avoid wearing damaged or worn stiletto heels.
- Place a protective mat under chairs with wheels.
- Place a protective dish under flowerpots.
- Do not drag heavy objects across the floor; lift them up to avoid scratches.
- Be careful with open windows - a rain shower can damage the floor.
- Make sure the humidity in the room is at least 45%. Use a humidifier, if necessary.
- Never use abrasive agents, as those can affect the gloss layer.
- Never use wax on a laminate floor.
- Use floor protectors and furniture legs/castors with a large ground surface to limit the impact of heavy objects
- Lamett laminate floors have a hard, closed surface, so that you needn't always clean it with a damp mop. Every once in a while will do. This way, you avoid lasting damage to your floor.

## 2. FIRST TREATMENT AFTER INSTALLATION

- Shake the can Bona Tile & Laminate Polish before use.
- Pour the polish on the floor in a wavy line of 3-4 cm wide. Work on a surface of 3m<sup>2</sup> at a time.
- Attention: do not use fibre, cotton or sponge cloths, etc.
- Spread the polish on the surface (3m<sup>2</sup>) with a woollen cleaning cloth.
- Make sure that the cloth stays moist with polish.
- Leave the floor to dry for at least 1h before walking on it.

## 3. REGULAR CLEANING

- Vacuum clean or sweep the floor to remove dirt/sand.
- If necessary, the floor may be cleaned with a well-wrung mop and Bona Tile and Laminate Cleaner.
- Avoid excessive use of water.

## 4. ANNUAL CLEANING

- Shake the can Bona Tile & Laminate Polish before use.
- Pour the polish on the floor in a wavy line of 3-4 cm wide. Work on a surface of 3m<sup>2</sup> at a time.
- Attention: do not use fibre, cotton or sponge cloths, etc.
- Spread the polish on the surface (3m<sup>2</sup>) with a woollen cleaning cloth.
- Make sure that the cloth stays moist with polish.
- Leave the floor to dry for at least 1h before walking on it.
